



Thursday, May 16: Depart U.S. for Istanbul, Turkey

Friday, May 17: Arrive Istanbul Arrive in Turkey's cultural and spiritual center and transfer to your hotel located near Taksim Square. As guests' arrival times may vary greatly, no group activities or meals are planned. You are free to explore the area surrounding the hotel or simply relax. Dinner tonight is on your own.

Saturday, May 18: Istanbul Begin with a walking tour along lively Istiklal Street, a pedestrian way lined with buildings dating to the late Ottoman era. View the acclaimed mosaics and frescoes at Chora Church (now Kariye Museum) then take a drive along Istanbul's Old City walls. Next, take a short walk through Balat, the traditional Jewish quarter, to the Spice Market. After lunch on your own, take a private cruise on the Bosphorus, the waterway which separates Europe from Asia. Back at your hotel, enjoy an exclusive lecture by a local expert on Turkey's political past and present. This evening, walk to a local restaurant for a welcome dinner of traditional Turkish fare. B,D

Sunday, May 19: Istanbul Tour Old Istanbul, beginning with the ancient Roman Hippodrome, a 3,500-year-old obelisk brought from Egypt in 390 AD. Continue on to the renowned Museum of Turkish & Islamic Art, home to many priceless artifacts dating from the 8th century. Next, visit the Blue Mosque, constructed of over 20,000 blue Iznik tiles and six signature minarets. After lunch at a local restaurant, continue on to Hagia Sophia, the 6th-century church that was the most important site in Christendom. *B*,*L*

Monday, May 20: Istanbul This morning, enjoy a tour highlight: a briefing at the U.S. Embassy. Later, tour splendid Topkapi Palace, considered one of the world's richest museums. Visit the Grand Bazaar, a covered market, comprised of 5,000 shops along 60 "streets." **B**

Tuesday, May 21: Istanbul/Gallipoli/Troy/ Assos Travel to the northern Aegean Coast for a brief visit to Gallipoli, site of 31 World War I Allied cemeteries. Then ferry across the Dardanelles to Troy, believed to exist only in Homer's epic poem. Continue south to Behramkale, ancient Assos, to spend the night. *B*,*L*,*D*

Wednesday, May 22: Assos/Pergamum/Izmir Explore the Hellenistic ruins at Pergamum, a major political power in the 3rd and 2nd centuries BC, and one of Turkey's most spectacular ancient sites. Then continue on to Izmir for the night. *B*,*L*,*D*

Thursday, May 23: Izmir/Ephesus Set off today to explore ancient Ephesus, Turkey's premier classical city dating to at least 1300 BC. Tour the immense ampitheater, the Temple of Hadrian, the library of Celsus, which once held 12,000 scrolls, and enjoy an exclusive expert guided visit of the Terrace Houses. Also, visit the acclaimed Ephesus Archaeological Museum before enjoying lunch in the rustic village of Sirince. *B*,*L*

Friday, May 24: Izmir/Göcek Journey south to coastal Göcek, with a stop along the way at a carpet factory for a demonstration of this age-old craft. Late afternoon board the *gulets*. *B*,*L*,*D*

Saturday, May 25: Cruising – Aga Limani/ Cleopatra Baths Begin your "Blue Voyage" with a cruise to the hidden cove of Aga Limani. From here, there is an optional three-hour hike to the Greco-Roman ruins at Lydea, which ends at the Sunken Baths of Cleopatra. Those who prefer a less strenuous day can stay aboard the *gulets* as they sail to the Sunken Baths. *B*,*L*,*D*

Sunday, May 26: Cruising – Ekincik Cove/ Dalyan Disembark the *gulets* and take a motorcoach to Dalyan, an environmentally protected area known for its loggerhead sea turtles. Here board a small skiff for a trip through an intriguing maze of channels where well-preserved ancient Lycian rock tombs are visible on the hills above. *B*,*L*,*D*

Monday, May 27: Cruising – Gemiler Island/Kayakoy This morning, tour the 6th-century Byzantine monastery on Gemiler Island. Next, take a motorcoach to the Greek "ghost town" of Kayakoy, abandoned after
